

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

As per UGC and NAAC guidelines, all higher education institutions are required to establish an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) to ensure continuous academic and administrative improvement. MNR University proposes the constitution of its IQAC to implement a structured quality assurance framework. It will oversee the development of quality benchmarks, promote a learner-centric environment, support faculty development, gather stakeholder feedback, and prepare the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR).

As per the UGC/NAAC guidelines, the composition of the IQAC of the MNR University shall be as follows:

2	Senior Administrative Officer (e.g., Registrar / Controller of Examinations / Finance Officer)	Member
3	Eight Senior Faculty Members representing all levels from various disciplines	Members
4	One Senior Teacher	IQAC Coordinator / Member Secretary
5	One Member/Nominee of the Sponsoring Body	Member
6	One Nominee from Local Society or Community / Alumni	Member
7	One Nominee from Students (preferably a PG or final-year UG student)	Member
8	One Nominee from Alumni	Member
9	One Nominee from Employers / Industry / Stakeholders	Member
10	Three External Experts from fields such as Quality Management, Industry, and the Local Community	Members

The term of appointment, meeting frequency, reporting and operational framework will be decided as per UGC/NAAC requirements
